2.1. Cash flow update

Ms Sarah Hutchings joined the meeting to review the latest cash flow forecast. Key highlights noted were: -No changes with the overall balance

-VAT payments were slightly higher than expected this quarter which was partly due to the slowing down on our capital expenditure

-LGPS payments - HR has advised Finance that their invoice for last year's round of VSS was still due, which would need to be taken into account

-Deferred non IT capital spend, this was due to Covid-19 impact

In terms of the outstanding decisions, Ms Hutchings noted:

-The severance cost has been updated

-The schedule of costs for the return to campus would be checked and updated
