#### 2.1. Cash flow update

SH joined the meeting to review the latest cashflow for this week. SH noted that as per last week, there wasn't much movement. Key headlines noted were:

- -more upfront fee income received as a result of January deposits
- -the revised Capital Grant income had not been applied yet. This was pending UET's review and decision
- -the first forecast would be done by end of this month for the Management Accounts and this would then be flowed through to the cashflow forecast

DR noted that SH had sent through last week the 'Faculty Capital Spend 2021/22' details which needed to be reviewed by UET. UET would review and come back to DR by end of this week with comments and decisions.

DR reviewed the two above bids.

- -the first one was adequate -cashflow negative but only during a few months, and good FEC rate.
- -the second one, the recovery rate was a bit lower than our targets. DR noted that overall, from a cashflow point of view, the bid was ok.

TMB commented that the gap in the recovery rate would be covered from our QR funds. JA added that this was also a valuable partner relationship.

On that basis, UET were content to approve both bids.
